Mr. Harvey M. Leake began his government career in 1983 with Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) in Marietta, Ga as a college summer hire. In 1985 Mr. Leake was selected for the Intern (keystone) training program under DLA, working in the DCASR Atlanta Quality Assurance

Directorate as an 801 General Engineer. Upon completion of the Intern program Mr. Leake was assignment to the QA Technical Management Division and Engineering Division

where he managed and supported various programs and process. In 1996 Mr. Leake moved to the DCMA Lockheed Martin Marietta, Ga Technical Management Group supporting various ACAT 1 aircraft and legacy programs. Mr. Leake worked as the Engineering Team Supervisor for the C130J program overseeing the delivery of the first customer aircrafts. He also served as the Lead Engineer for the F-22 program overseeing various customer productions and engineering requirements.

In 2007 - 2011 Mr. Leake worked as the Technical Group Chief for DCMAI Americas, Ottawa Canada overseeing the management of customer technical requirements in Canada, Central America, South America, and the Caribbean. Mr. Leake also served as the DCMA Americas London, Ontario Tertiary Commander supporting the production of the Light Armored Vehicles (LAV and Stryker) and fielding of the first MRAPs to Afghanistan.

Mr. Leake worked in the DCMA HQ Operations QA Directorate and Technical Directorate Engineering from 2011 – 2019 supporting the DCMA Regions and DCMA CMOs for policy implementation and compliance. Mr. Leake was the Coordinator for the Quality Management System (QMS) audit program, NCM/ MA Instructor, NASA QA POC, Missile Defense POC, Strategic System Programs IGD, Specialty Metals POC.

Mr. Leake did three Contingency Contracting (CCAS) tours of duty, serving in Kuwait as the Theater Technical Director, serving in Afghanistan as the Central Command (CENTCOM) Combatting Trafficking in Persons (CTIP) Program Manager. Mr. Leake directed and supported CTIP operations in over 8 countries in CENTCOM. Mr. Leake returned to DCMA Lockheed Martin Marietta, GA in 2019 currently serving as a senior lead engineer for the Engineering and Analysis Directorate.

Mr. Leake is a graduate of Southern Poly Tech (Kennesaw State) with a BS in Mechanical Engineering (1985), Marietta, Ga, and Benedict College, Columbia, SC, with a BS in Physics (1984).
